Airway Airport Loop Sewer Rehab

OC San provides wastewater collection, treatment, and recycling services for approximately 2.6 million people in central and northwest Orange County. The OC San Airway-Airport Loop Sewer Rehabilitation Project is part of a larger capital improvement program to maintain and improve the regional sewer infrastructure.

About the Project

The Airway-Airport Loop Sewer Rehabilitation Project will rehabilitate two parallel regional sewer pipelines along a 1-mile stretch on Airway Avenue and Airport Loop Drive in the City of Costa Mesa, near the John Wayne Airport. The rehabilitation of the two pipelines must occur one at a time and will take place in separate phase to ensure continuous and uninterrupted sewer service.

Why Is This Infrastructure Needed?

OC San is committed to protecting public health and the environment by proactively maintaining its infrastructure. The project is needed to enhance aging infrastructure and extend the life of the regional sewer system.
