



Costa Mesa Sewer Rehabilitation Along the I-405

Construction on the **Costa Mesa Sewer Rehabilitation Along the I-405 Project** (Along the 405) has been in progress since Fall 2024. The work has been done in segments as to not affect the entire 4-mile project alignment all at once. Construction will be coming soon to your neighborhood.

Locations: Near or along Olympic Ave., Tanana Pl., Yukon Ave., Concord St., Charleston St., and San Leandro Ln.

What: May include the installation of bypass pipes and pumps to temporarily reroute sewer flows to allow for uninterrupted sewer service, vacator trucks to remove flows out of the pipeline, pipeline cleaning, inspection, and rehabilitation. Increased activity and noise are expected near the construction areas.

When: June 2025 - July 2025*
Approximately 1 week per segment.

Hours:*

- Will vary by location but are typically Monday - Friday, 7 a.m. - 4 p.m.
- San Leandro Ln. location: Night Work, 9 p.m. - 6 a.m.
- Pipeline rehabilitation will require continuous uninterrupted work which is expected to extend outside normal working hours.

**All dates and times are subject to change due to operational factors or inclement weather.*

Project Information

The **Costa Mesa Sewer Rehabilitation Along the I-405 Project** (Along the 405) will rehabilitate approximately 4 miles of the regional sewer pipeline that runs along the I-405 freeway in the City of Costa Mesa. The project will rehabilitate sewer pipelines, manhole structures, and improve access to manholes. The project also includes the rehabilitation of several sewer pipelines that cross under the freeway.

Project Need

OC San is committed to protecting public health and the environment by proactively replacing and maintaining its infrastructure. The existing sewer line was constructed in the 1960s and needs to be rehabilitated and repair cracks in the pipe to extend its useful life for another 25-30 years and to continue providing reliable sewer service.
